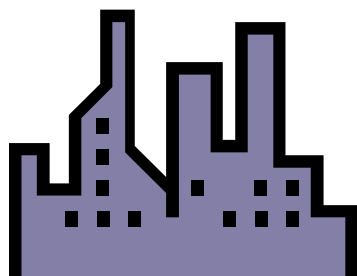


AROUND THE BUILDING
