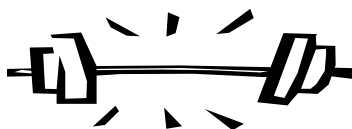


Building Projects

Many capital projects were included in the 2007 budget; some have already been completed and some are underway. Tuckpointing to the garage wall and building foundation was completed, cleaning of the lobby metal, including the elevator doors (inside/out), window frames, 3 doors out to the garage, and mailbox doors. The lobby floors were polished, and the resurfacing of the pool will soon begin. Finally, Jesse Horvath has begun evaluating HVAC unit sleeve design as part of the process to correct window leakage.

Declaration Amendments

Over the past few months, you have received information regarding amending the 2500 Lakeview Association Declaration to update antiquated sections. Your vote is very important to affect these changes. Currently the vote tally shows that the Association does not yet have enough votes (75% required) to pass the proposed amendments, therefore the voting will continue with the hope to reach that goal. Illinois Condominium law provides a one-year period in which the proxy you voted is valid. The vote you turned in **is still valid** and counts; if you did **not** turn in a vote, please do so as soon as possible. You may leave it with the doorman, in the mgmt office, or in the suggestion box outside the building office.
